This term our topics are Winter and Festivals.



In Literacy we will be continuing to learn our letter sounds in our phonics sessions, we will then spend some time on reading and writing four and five letter words and introducing the children to di-grams- 2 letters making one sound ( sh, ch, th)

We will be developing our writing by introducing the concept of writing a full sentence including basic punctuation.

In Maths, we will be building upon our skills of counting and number recognition focusing upon the teen numbers to 20. We will also develop our skills of simple addition and subtraction and problem solving .

We will be looking at winter weather and talking about different clothes we wear to keep warm. If we are lucky and get some snow, we will explore how our world changes. If not, we will explore ice in class and look at melting and freezing.

In Willow class, we will be celebrating the Chinese New Year, this year it is the year of the dog. There will be decorations to make, dances to perform and cooking some yummy stir fries to eat!
